“Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment.” (Romans 12:3b NIV)

#3 An “I Can Do Everything _____” Attitude

“But, O my soul, don’t be discouraged. Don’t be upset. Expect God to act! For I know that I shall again have plenty of reason to praise him for all that he will do. He is my help! He is my God!” (Psalm 42:11 TLB)

#4 An “I Can Do Everything Through Christ, _____” Attitude

“But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.” (Isaiah 40:31 KJV)
